Athletic Department Update

- Final installment of new gym wall padding expected to arrive and be installed this week.

 - Thursday, 2/5 JV Basketball doubleheader vs. Whitman at home at 3:30 and 5:15 PM.
- Varsity Girls basketball & Indoor Track high-jumper Bakari (9th in nation) featured in Washington Post; Bakari competed in Hispanic Games on 01/04/25 and broke his school record to 6 foot 8 inches

Financial Report

- December financials are similar to November.

- Membership figures are consistent with last year although revenue up approx \$500.
- Banner sales & concessions are down 25-30% due to fewer home events and fewer sales. But costs are also down due to lower inventory purchases.
- Concessions & school store have had lower expenses compared to last year due to lower inventory purchases.
- Revenue is down 20% from first half of last year. Profit margin overall is 11% higher than last year despite revenue being down.

 - QR codes will be posted throughout the venue so attendees can donate to the Booster Club during the event.
 - All head coaches will be invited to attend for free. The goal is for all assistant coaches who would like to attend, to receive a ticket donated by parents. The Committee will ask the teams to purchase tickets for their assistant coaches who would like to attend.
 - Will not have items for auction or games due to lack of interest last year.
