Welcome and President's Update (Steve & Chris)

Review and Approval of 05/13/26 Booster Club Membership Minutes

Treasurer Report (Jamie was not present)

- Will circulate the numbers later.
- It was a good year and everything is on track.

Around the Grounds:

Concessions (Paige (not present) & Amy (present))

- Paige is officially out, she is moving to GA
- Wrapping up and cleaning up the stand
- There is a remainder supply of water and gatorade that will be stored in the refrigerator for the summer.
- Will need more staffing – about 4-5 managers for the concession stands
 - Students are an option but will need to be incentivized with more than giving SLL hours. Maybe give gift cards to certain venues since paying them is not an option.
 - There will be a structured process to choose the students with a formal interview process to weed out people who are not serious. Don't want to rotate people. (Jesse agreed that it is a good idea)
 - Amy, Chris and Steve will work together to come up with a process
 - Create 2-3 bullet points about what it entails to become managers.

- How to get the coaches involved in getting the commitment from parents to work the concession stands.
- Create a Master Calendar that lists all the games for the season to get commitment from people ahead of time. Parents will get reminder emails.
 - Consulting Hours are available for them to create this feature.
- Budget is available to buy another shed if needed to store things.
- Need to create a better process to improve the food system. (Steve will look into that)
- Automate the food system with the addition of TV screens.
 - Amy and Paige will put a list together of what is needed.
- Jesse - SGA indicated they are interested in doing concession stands for the volleyball season.
 - There is no objection from the Leadership Team and they indicated that while SGA can use the fridge they can't use other equipment.
- There were suggestions to combine the SGA interested kids with the manager student program for the general concession stand.
